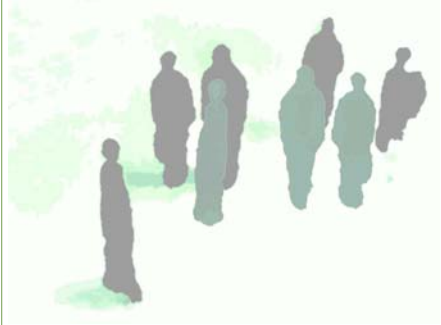

Drs. Fredrik Fogelberg CMC is an industrial and organisational psychologist specializing in leadership development and team facilitation in international organizations. He and his American/Dutch business partner co-direct Nomadic Life Management Consultants in the Netherlands. Their client base represents the airline/hotel, consulting, finance, IT, manufacturing, patent, petrochemical, retail, space and telecom sectors.

He coaches and trains industrial leaders and their teams in how to “get the job done”, in a complex, international and changing business environment in which they work. He uses six working languages (Dutch, English, French, German, Norwegian and Swedish) and another three for conversation (Finnish, Russian and Spanish).

Before starting his own consultancy business, Fredrik worked as a corporate trainer and manager for KLM Royal Dutch Airlines and Nike Europe.

He studied French at the Université de Grenoble and received his Masters (drs) in Industrial & Organisational Psychology from the University of Amsterdam. He completed postgraduate studies in group dynamics and coaching at IAS in the Netherlands. He was trained by Fons Trompenaars in cross-cultural communication. Additional qualifications include “family constellations” by Hellinger in Germany, and training in psychopathology, stress and burnout. Recently he became a qualified mediator.

He has been an invited speaker at SIETAR (Society for Intercultural Education and Research) conferences in France and Italy and conferences in the USA and the Netherlands on the Assessment Center Method. He is a contributing author to *Global Competence 50 Training Activities in International Business* from HRD Press and has been published in the Netherlands on the dynamics of cross-cultural teams. He holds memberships in the Netherlands Instituut voor Psychologen (NIP) and is a senior associate of the Center for Creative Leadership in Brussels.
